## SAFARI PLAN

### DAY 1: ZANZIBAR → TARANGIRE OR SERVAL → KARATU

- 04:30–05:00 – Hotel pick-up and transfer to Zanzibar airport
- 07:00 – Flight to Arusha
- Upon arrival – choose one of the two experiences:

#### Option A: Tarangire National Park

- Game drive among iconic baobabs
- Spot elephants, zebras, giraffes, and more in a classic savannah setting
- Peaceful and less crowded than other parks

#### Option B: Serval Wildlife Sanctuary (*upgrade option*)

- Walk through the sanctuary with a guide
- Close-up encounters with white lions, caracals, giraffes
- Ideal for families and unique photo opportunities

  

- Afternoon transfer to Karatu
- Dinner and overnight at Foresight Ecolodge – eco-friendly and surrounded by nature

### DAY 2: NGORONGORO CRATER → ZANZIBAR

- Early breakfast
- Descent into Ngorongoro Crater – a natural amphitheater teeming with wildlife
- Game drive in the crater – lions, buffalos, hippos, flamingos, jackals, and maybe even black rhinos
- Picnic lunch by a hippo pool
- Afternoon transfer to Arusha Airport
- Evening flight back to Zanzibar (approx. 18:00–20:00)
- Hotel drop-off in Zanzibar
